“May you live in interesting times”, as the old saying goes. Well, we certainly do. Since my election in 2019 we have seen our world change immeasurably. Back then, the slogan of “Get Brexit Done” saw a clear majority emerge in Westminster as people were increasingly weary of the politics of division and anger that had been prevalent over the preceding few years and the country's voters pushed Boris Johnson into a strong position of power. A large number of people I spoke to at that time were persuaded by the “Get Brexit Done” message – and we have. The will of the majority of the people across the UK and in Delyn has finally been delivered, in line with the promises I made during the campaign to work for that to happen. I look forward to meeting many more of you over the coming months and years as we make a real difference in Delyn together, and nothing will stop me speaking up for my constituents and the wider North Wales region in my drive to improve people's lives both now and in the future.




